AGES: Girls aged 14-18 (Open to Any and All Entrants)

DESCRIPTION

The Elite Training Camp is intended for players who are driven to train and compete at the college level. Strength training, video analysis, and positional training are examples of sessions provided. Enrollment is limited to 80 participants per camp to ensure the most optimal training environment possible.

GOALKEEPING

Under the direction of Wisconsin's goalkeeper coach, Tim Rosenfeld, the Elite Training Camps will provide specific goalkeeper instruction. Enrollment is limited to 8 goalkeepers per camp to ensure an optimal training environment.

COACHING STAFF

Paula Wilkins, Camp Director: Paula begins her 6th year at the helm of the Wisconsin Women's Soccer program. In her coaching career Paula has won nine Big Ten Championships; four Big Ten Tournament Championships; and appeared in three College Cups. She has also coached nine first team All-Americans and has been a staff coach with Region I and Region II ODP as well as the National Team.

Tim Rosenfeld, Assistant Camp Director: Tim begins his 6th year as the Associate Coach of the Wisconsin Women's Soccer program. Previously, he spent 6 years as Coach Wilkin's top assistant at Penn State University. Prior to that, Tim spent three years as the Head Coach of the Women's Soccer program at St. Francis University (PA). A former professional goalkeeper, Tim will be coordinating the goalkeeping instruction.

Patrick Farmer, Assistant Camp Director: Patrick begins his 5th season at Wisconsin. A two-time national coach of the year honoree, Farmer has turned programs into perennial powers at every stop in his coaching career; including producing two national championship teams at Division III Ithaca College and building Penn State into a national title contender. Most recently, Coach Farmer was the Head Women's Soccer Coach at Syracuse University.

This premiere coaching staff is one of the finest in the country developing three (3) NCAA Herman Player of the Year Award Winners/Runner-ups, nine (9) first team All-American selections, nine (9) Big Ten Championships and several Olympic and World Cup players. Paula, Tim and Pat know what it takes to develop good players and can teach the foundations to prepare any soccer player for the future. LODGING, MEALS AND FACILITIES

The Elite Training Camps will utilize University Housing. University Housing residence halls provide student-style housing conveniently located on campus near the camp fields. Each air-conditioned room includes twin beds with bed linens and pillows, micro-fridges, desks, internet, and cable television connections (via personal laptop) and shared bathroom facilities. Floor lounges include televisions and telephones with free local calls. Laundry and vending machines are located within most halls. Meals provide a variety of youth-friendly and healthy selections, including vegetarian options. The first meal served will be lunch on DAY 1. The final meal served will be breakfast on DAY 3.

Registration for Elite Training Camp II will take place at Sullivan Residence Hall (635 Elm Drive, Madison, WI 53711) on Thursday, July 12th between 10:00 am and 11:00 am. Closing remarks will be held at Sullivan Residence Hall on Saturday, July 14th between 12:00 pm and 12:45 pm.

WHAT TO BRING

Please bring training gear, soccer shoes/cleats, running/training shoes, shin guards, goalkeeping gear if applicable, and a soccer ball. The ETC will provide each player with two training shirts, two pairs of Adidas training shorts, two pairs of Adidas socks, a water bottle, and an Adidas carry pack. All gear will be red, white, gray and/or black. We request that you bring some extra t-shirts, shorts and socks that are in these colors if at all possible. You will also need towels, soap and shampoo.

SOCCER BALL

If you would like to purchase an Adidas soccer ball, please indicate this on the registration page; or email Tim Rosenfeld at tmr@athletics.wisc.edu. The soccer ball cost is \$30.

MEDICAL CARE

University of Wisconsin Athletic Trainers will be on duty 24 hours a day to care for minor injuries and ailments. For more serious issues, the UW Hospital is only minutes away.

PARKING

There will be a "no ticket time" for both check-in and check-out. However, if you will be keeping a vehicle on campus for duration of camp, you must pre-purchase a parking permit. To obtain a permit please call the UW parking office at 608-262-8683 three (3) weeks before your camp session. The cost is \$12 per day.

INSURANCE

Each camper must have their own medical coverage. The camp offers secondary coverage, which is limited to \$1000 per injury.

ROOMMATE PREFERENCE

University Housing rules allow only two to a room. We will attempt to keep campers together who request a specific roommate. However, writing down a roommate does not ensure that person will be accepted to that session and does not hold a place for that person. We strongly suggest that roommates send applications in together to better ensure that they both get into their preferred session and can room together.
